
If you do not have access to a smartphone or tablet you can still view our courses online using the website above, or call **01752 305300** and talk to our friendly and helpful College Information team.



FUNDING YOUR COURSE

Returning to education can be intimidating especially for those with financial commitments but there is support available for many of our courses and some courses might even be free depending on your circumstances.

Student Bursary

The College's Student Bursary provides financial or 'in kind' help to eligible students aged 19+ with a number of course-related costs. These funds are aimed at those most in need and are dependent on household income.

Paying in instalments

Please note that we offer instalment arrangements for the tuition fees element for many of our courses. You will be asked to pay a minimum of 25% before, or at enrolment, followed by up to a further three instalments depending on the length of your course.

Advanced Learner Loans

If you are aged 19+ and you are thinking about studying a course that is level 3 or above then you could be eligible for an Advanced Learner Loan.

Key facts:

- Advanced Learner Loans are for the upfront tuition costs of your course
- loans are not means tested or credit checked
- you don't start repaying the loan until you earn at least £27.295
- the minimum loan you can get is £300
- if your loan is to cover the fees for an Access to Higher Education course and you progress to complete a university-level (higher education) course, you will not have to pay back your Advanced Learner Loan.
