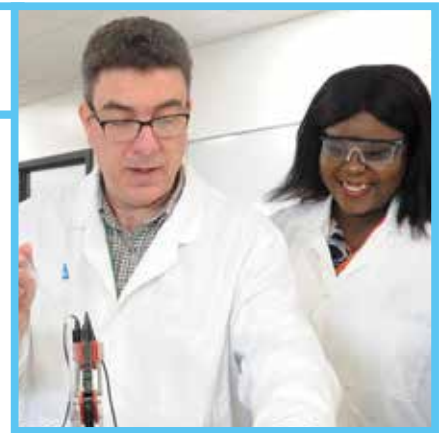

# FUNDING YOUR COURSE

## You may be entitled to a FREE course if you:

- are earning less than £17,004 (gross) per year\*\*
- would like to study functional skills in English and maths - excluding English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)
- would like to study GCSE English or GCSE Maths and you do not already hold grades 9 to 4 (or A\* to C under the old system) in these subjects
- are aged between 19 and 23 and this is your first eligible\*\* full level 2 qualification (ie equivalent to five GCSEs at grades 9 to 4 or A\* to C, BTEC First Certificate or an NVQ Level 2)
- are aged 19+ and this is your first eligible\*\* full level 3 qualification (ie equivalent to two A Levels at grades A\* to C, BTEC National Certificate/Diploma or an NVQ Level 3)
- would like to gain a level 2 qualification, but first need to gain an entry/level 1 qualification (certain other criteria applies)
- are unemployed and in receipt of certain benefits\*\*.

## Student Bursary

The College's Student Bursary provides financial or 'in kind' help to eligible students aged 19+ with a number of course-related costs. These funds are aimed at those most in need and are dependent on household income.

## Paying in instalments

Please note that we offer instalment arrangements for the tuition fees element for many of our courses. You will be asked to pay a minimum of 25% before, or at enrolment, followed by up to a further three instalments depending on the length of your course. Instalment arrangements are managed through our recurring card payment system. Please note instalment facilities are not available for ancillary (material) or other course costs, or for short courses that run for fewer than ten weeks.

# ADVANCED LEARNER LOANS

19+

If you are aged 19+ and you are thinking about studying a course that is level 3\* or above then you could be eligible for an Advanced Learner Loan.

## To qualify for an Advanced Learner Loan you must:

- be aged 19+ at the start of your course
- be a resident in the UK
- be studying an eligible course at level 3 or above (including QCF Certificates and Diplomas, and Access to Higher Education).

## Key facts:

- you will only be able to apply for a loan to meet the upfront tuition costs of your qualification, which will be paid directly to the College
- loans are not means tested or credit checked so if you meet the criteria you will be able to apply for a loan whether you are employed or unemployed
- you don't pay anything upfront for your course fees and if you're not earning over £27,295, you won't have to pay anything back (certain criteria apply)
- the minimum loan you can get is £300 and is paid directly to the College
- if your loan is to cover the fees for an Access to Higher Education course and you progress to complete a university-level (higher education) course, you will not have to pay back your Advanced Learner Loan.

## Applying for a loan

When you have a confirmed place on a course, you can apply online for your loan at [www.gov.uk/advanced-learner-loan](http://www.gov.uk/advanced-learner-loan). You will need to register before applying. This link also has more information on the Advanced Learner Loan scheme, including information on the amounts available and the collection of repayments.















If you need help completing the online or paper application, you can pop in to see us from Monday to Friday, 9.00am - 4.00pm.

\* **PLEASE NOTE:** if you are applying for your first full level 3 course (equivalent to A Level) and you are aged 19 - 23, then your course is FREE!
