\* You could be eligible if you:

- want to study adult literacy and numeracy, or functional skills in literacy and numeracy – excluding English for Speakers of other Languages (ESOL)
- want to study GCSE English or maths if you don't already hold an A-C grade
- are aged between 19 and 23 and this is your first eligible\* full level 2 qualification (ie equivalent to five GCSEs at grades A to C, BTEC First Certificate or an NVQ Level 2)
- are aged between 19 and 23 and this is your first eligible\* full level 3 qualification (ie equivalent to two A Levels at grades A to C, BTEC National Certificate/Diploma or an NVQ Level 3)
- want to get a level 2 qualification, but first need to get an entry/level 1 qualification (certain other criteria applies)
- are unemployed and in receipt of Jobseekers Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance (work related activity group only) or Universal Credit\*\*
- are unemployed or earning less than £330 per month and getting state benefits (other than JSA, ESA (WRAG) or Universal Credit) and the course is directly relevant to your employment prospects and the local job market requirements.
